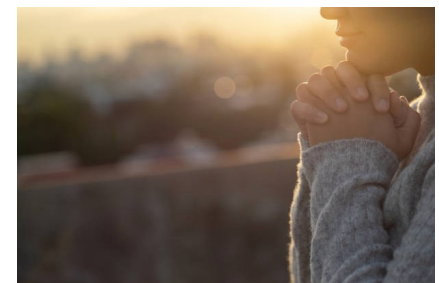
Finding I AM and The Armor of God
